

PART 1: Introduction to MiMAS

Q1: What is the MiMAS competition?

Ans: MiMAS stands for Malaysia international Mathematical Arithmetic for Schools. The competition includes the following categories: ❶ Arithmetic (MAO) ❷ Mathematics (MMI) ❸ Memory (MMT) ❹ Abacus (OMMC).

More than 600 schools participate in MiMAS annually, making it one of the renowned mathematical and mental arithmetic competitions in Malaysia.

Q2: Who can participate in MiMAS?

Ans: All primary and secondary school students studying in Malaysia, including local students (Malaysian citizens) and international students (foreign passport holders). All participants must be below the age of 19.

Q3: What is the main language of the competition?

Ans: The competition papers are available in three languages: Malay, English and Mandarin.

Q4: How can I register for the MiMAS competition?

Ans: Please check with your school's co-curricular vice principal or mathematics teacher to see if your school will set up a MiMAS competition center. If so, please register with the school teacher.

(i) School Registration: The organizers encourage students to register through their school teacher, certificates and medals will be delivered to the school. To prevent the loss of certificates or medals, if the school does not have a teacher in charge, students are required to register individually.

(ii) Individual Registration: Students can register through the MiMAS official website (<https://mimas.my>), certificates or medals will be delivered to their home address.

Q5: What are the MiMAS registration fees?

Ans: Based on [School Registration] and [Individual Registration], the registration fees for each category are as follows:

p/s: For [Individual Registration], certificates or medals will be delivered to the home address.

Q6: When is the registration deadline?

Ans: The registration deadline for the MiMAS competition is 15th April 2025.

PART 2: MiMAS Competition Format

Q1: What is the format for the Arithmetic category (MAO)?

Ans: The Arithmetic category (MAO) must be registered through the [School Registration] and is only allowed as an offline physical paper-based competition at the school [competition center].

Participants must complete three papers (Paper A, B and C), 5 minutes each.

Q2: What is the format for the Mathematics category (MMI)?

Ans: Mathematics category (MMI) can be registered through [School Registration] or [Individual Registration].

[School Registration] is an offline physical paper-based competition, while [Individual Registration] is an online competition.

The paper for Mathematics category (MMI) consists of 30 questions to be completed within 60 minutes.

- 20 multiple-choice questions (logical reasoning – objective questions)
- 10 short-answer questions (problem solving – subjective questions)

Q3: What is the format for the Memory category (MMT)?

Ans: Memory category (MMT) can be registered through [School Registration] or [Individual Registration], both are online competitions.

Participants must answer 30 questions related to pi, image memorizing, number memorizing, continuous memorizing, fictitious historical events, etc. within 30 minutes.

Q4: What is the format for the Abacus category (OMMC)?

Ans: Abacus category (OMMC) can be registered through [School Registration] or [Individual Registration], both are online competitions.

Participants must complete three papers (Paper A, B and C), 5 minutes each.

Q5: Where can I download mock test papers?

Ans: You can download mock test papers from the MiMAS official website: <https://mimas.my>

Q6: What are the awards for MiMAS?

Ans: (i) All participants will receive a certificate.

(ii) Outstanding students will be awarded Gold, Silver, Bronze, and Distinction awards based on their results:

Gold Award	Top 2%.
Silver Award	Next 8%.
Bronze Award	Next 10%.
Distinction	Next 15%.

Q7: When will the MiMAS results be announced?

Ans: The results are expected to be announced in mid-June 2025. Students can check their results through their accounts or on the MiMAS website and Facebook page.

Q8: Will all participants receive an e-certificate?

Ans: Yes! Once results are announced, all participants can log in to their accounts to download their e-certificates.

PART 3: Awards for MiMAS Winners

Q1: How can MiMAS winners qualify for the Shenmo Cup International Competition?

Ans: MiMAS Gold Award winners will be invited to participate in the Shenmo Cup International Competition for free.

Q2: When will the Shenmo Cup International Competition take place?

Ans: The 2025 Shenmo Cup International Competition details:

Date: 12th July 2025 (Saturday)

Venue: Setia City Convention Centre

Q3: What competitions will MiMAS winners be invited to participate in?

Ans: Winners (Gold, Silver, Bronze and Distinction Awards) from the MiMAS [Arithmetic], [Memory] and [Abacus] categories will be invited to participate in the 2025 WMA Shenmo Cup Invitational.

Winners (Gold, Silver, Bronze and Distinction Awards) from the MiMAS [Mathematics] category will be invited to participate in the 2025 MMIC (Malaysia Mathematics Invitational Championship).

PART 4: Other Questions

Q1: My school does not set up a MiMAS competition center. Can I register for MiMAS individually?

Ans: Yes, you can register for MiMAS individually through the MiMAS website (<https://mimas.my>).

After the results are announced, certificates or medals will be delivered to your home address.

Q2: I encountered a “payment unsuccessful” message when registering online. What should I do?

Ans: Please contact our customer support via WhatsApp and provide your child's name and IC number for assistance.

Q3: Can I request a refund after registration?

Ans: No. Once registered, the fee is non-refundable, regardless of the reason.

If a student is unable to attend the competition on the day, the registration fee will not be refunded.

Q4: When will the MiMAS competition be held at schools?

Ans: The Ministry of Education encourages schools to hold competitions after school hours in accordance with the Ministry of Education's guidelines.

Please check with the school teacher for the MiMAS competition schedule.

Q5: Can students bring stationery to the competition?

Ans: Yes. Students may bring 2B pencils, eraser and ruler, but calculator is not allowed.

Q6: Can students use an abacus for the Arithmetic category (MAO) and the Abacus category (OMMC)?

Ans: Yes, students are allowed to use an abacus.
